Dear Mr Beasley,
Last October, I received a portion of WFAI's broadcasts. At that time, I submitted a reception report outlining what I had heard over WFAI. Since I have received no confirmation of my reception of WFAI as yet, it appears that my report went astray somewhere along the line. I am very anxious to add WFAI to my list of confirmed AM broadcast stations, & so am submitting my report again.

My hobby is listening to the standard AM broadcast band for radio stations, writing to the stations informing them of my reception & requesting a confirmation of this reception. I have confirmed over 2500 stations & am quite anxious to add WFAI to this collection. (Particularly since we left N.C.) I guess & announcements I heard over WFAI on Monday, October 30, 1972, are in the attached log. I monitored 1230 for quite a while that morning, however you were only distinguishable from the others on 1230 the several times noted. Most interference was from WNOR, who packs quite a signal in here, plus other assorted stations.
May I suggest a confirmation format - this on your WFAI letterhead -

"Mr. Sampson -
This will confirm your reception of WFAI on 10/30/72.
(Signed) ... *Stout Wilcof* *General Mgr.*

That would be perfect for my collection & not too much trouble for you, I hope. I've also enclosed the self-addressed, stamped envelope to further facilitate reply.
