This is to confirm your reception of WHBT on 28 May, 1970. We are always pleased to get reports such as yours. Please pardon the delay in my answer.

WHBT operates under pre-sunrise authority, so at the time you heard us, we were indeed on 500 watts. Our transmitter is a Collins 21 E/M, which is a convertible model capable of 10,000 watt operation. Despite its age it maintains normal frequency drift of an average ± 1 cycle, which is pretty close for 1.6mc. Our antenna is a non-directional guyed tower 200' high (203.5 overall). As per request, here is our letterhead; a unique feature of which is the coat of arms of our group. Hope this is a satisfactory reply. Thanks again for your report.
