Monitoring Report for Radio Station WIKI on 1410 kHz.  
Date Wednesday June 14, 1972 Monitoring period 6:00 AM to 6:01 AM Eastern Daylight.

It was my pleasure to monitor transmissions from your station during the above period. As proof of reception I offer this log of items heard:  
6:00 The National Anthem was played. Then, this sign on an-  
nouncement was given. I tape recorded it & copied it best as I could (al tho your signal faded near the end & was covered by others signing on. What I could copy was as follows:

"Good morning. This is WIKI, Chester, Virginia, be-  
ginning another day of broadcasting activity. WIKI  
operates on a frequency of 1410 kilohertz with a pre-  
sunrise power output of 500 watts & a sunrise  
power output of 5000 watts, non-directional as  
authorized by the Federal Communications Commission (over)

On the basis of the above details, I wish to request a brief letter confirming the fact that I have received your station's signals. I collect these letters as a hobby and would be most pleased to add your confirmation to my collection. For your convenience in replying I have enclosed return postage. Thank you for your time and consideration. I hope this report has been of interest to you.

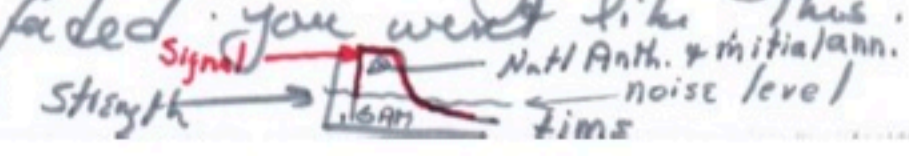
Al tho my reception of WIKI was quite brief, I sincerely hope that the word-for-word copy will enable a con-

Technical Information: Receiving equipment: Hammarlund HQ-180A with 1 foot shielded ferrite loop antenna

Interfering stations: Very little during your initial sign on however became more troublesome as your signal faded. you went like this:

Reception conditions: Quite good - no static  
Other stations confirmed in your area: WGOE, WHAP, WAVA



Washington, D.C. WIKI studios & transmitter are located at 10600 Jefferson Davis Highway . . . you faded out about here & I think went in to a news cast. However, I was unable to tell for certain, since several others on 1410 (including WRIS, WSRC & WEGO, the three I re-ceive during the day.)
