Dear Mr. Simpson;

First, let me apologize for not replying to your earlier letter concerning verification of reception of our signal.

Your summary of reception is correct as stated. You might be interested in what our facilities are since we changed operations one year ago this month. W.M.G.A. presently operates on a frequency of 1130 Kc. (having changed from 1300Kc.) with a power output of 10,000 watts, non-directional antenna system, daytime hours. 10,000 watts, directional system, critical hours, and 250 watts, directional system during nighttime hours. We switched to this power and frequency on April 18, 1969 from a fulltime operation of 1000 watts daytime, 250 watts nighttime power on the afore mentioned frequency of 1300 Kc.

Trusting this information will be of interest to you, and will sufficiently fill your requirements of verification.
