Monitoring Report for Radio Station WPED on 810 kHz.

Date Thursday July 6, 1972 Monitoring period 6:05 AM to 6:11 AM Eastern Daylight Time.

It was my pleasure to monitor transmissions from your station during the above period. As proof of reception I offer this log of items heard:

- 6:05 Country & western song by Charlie Pride (in progress)
- 6:07 Ad for Old Milwaukee BEER & mention was made that it is locally distributed by The Kirtlie (Kirtley?) Distributing Co of Charlottesville
- 6:08 Announcement of the time & that the program host would be "with you 'til 12" - then weather conditions for the area, including a flood warning for the James River
- 6:10 Announcement of the time & a musical announcement - "WPED - with the weather" then a weather forecast was given
- 6:11 A Country & western song started & your signal faded - this time for good.

On the basis of the above details, I wish to request a brief letter confirming the fact that I have received your station's signals. I collect these letters as a hobby and would be most pleased to add your confirmation to my collection. For your convenience in replying I have enclosed return postage. Receiving equipment: Hammarlund HQ-180A with 1 foot ferrite loop antenna - used to null WKBC.

Interfering stations: Heavy from WKBC (semi local here during the day) & WCEC. You were on top of them only during the Beer ad & otherwise I had to dig you out from behind them.

Good - no static
