WPJD has been broadcasting since May of last year. Our equipment is all new and produces some superb fidelity in our primary coverage area. We are using a CCA 250D transmitter and 200' folded-unipole antenna located in a swampy area in the southern part of Daisy.

Our coverage is not so good in the daytime, but it seems to be great as far as the nighttime skip is concerned; we receive reports from all over the country when we are testing.
