Dear Mr. Bailey,

Last December, I received a portion of WROL's broadcasts. At that time, I submitted a report outlining what I had heard over WROL. Since I haven't received any confirmation as yet, it appears that my report went astray somewhere along the line. I am very anxious to add WROL to my list of verified AM broadcast stations, & so am submitting my report again.

My hobby is listening to the standard AM broadcast band for radio stations, writing to the stations informing them of my reception & requesting a verification of reception from the stations. I have collected over 2100 verifications from different stations & am quite anxious to add WROL to my collection.

Items & announcements I heard over WROL on Saturday, December 14, 1968, are in the attached log. You were pretty well on top of 1490 & fairly easy to read, however, there was quite a bit of interference from the other stations on that frequency.

May I suggest this verification format - This written on your letterhead -

This will verify your reception of WROL on 12/14/68.
(Signed) ...

That would not take too much of your time, & would be perfect for my collection. I have enclosed the self-addressed, stamped envelope to further facilitate reply.
