Gentlemen:

Enclosed is a WRFM-FM 100,000 watt coverage map with red lines to indicate WRFM-AM 10,000 watt primary and secondary coverage.

The WRFM-FM coverage map shows a radius of one hundred miles. It reaches from above Laurel in the north to below New Orleans in the south, and from Baton Rouge on the west to Mobile on the east.

WRFM-AM, 10,000 watts since 1967, shows a primary coverage that reaches above Hattiesburg in the north to below Slidell in the south, and beyond Franklinton on the west to beyond Wiggins on the east. Including WRFM-AM secondary coverage, the two stations have almost the same coverage. Both stations put a very good selling signal into New Orleans and across the entire Gulf Coast.

Although we advertise the fact that we program good music on WAFM-AM and WRFM-FM, we do not simulcast. Good music is a different type radio format for this area and has met with surprisingly good acceptance. Many people in the area, who had long since quit listening to radio, are now enjoying our good music stations. From all reports we have a tremendous listening audience from sign on till sign off on both WRFM-AM and on WRFM-FM. The WRFM-AM station is a daytime station while WRFM-FM is a full time station offering night time programming for an area served, before now, by daytime AM stations only.

Included is our 10,000 watt AM rate card. As a promotion for 1970 we are using our original 1,000 watt rate card dated April 1963 when WRFM AM first went on the air. You will also find 1970 promotional rates for our 100,000 watt FM station stapled to the front of our AM rate card.

With our extensive coverage and our good music programming we are reaching an ever growing market which means more value for your advertising dollar.
