Dear Mr. Sampson

This is to confirm your report of reception of station WRYT on December 29, 1969 from 2:32 to 3:07 am EST. The details which you have supplied correspond exactly to the programming we transmitted during the Test and we are happy to be able to verify your reception of WRYT.

WRYT operates from sunrise to sunset on a frequency of 950 kHz with a power output of 5,000 watts; WRYT's antenna is a nondirectional 200' tower overlooking the Saugus town dump. The once extensive ground system was looted by copper thieves some years ago and very little now remains of it.

Because of the relocation of several of the individuals involved with this Test, the mailing of verifications is unfortunately very late and we apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused.

Many NRC members heard the WRYT Test that AM including Ernie Cooper, Jerry Starr, Alan Merriman, Frank Waldron, and yourself, to name a few. The Boston NRC HQ crew on hand during the Test had a great time conducting it and speaking with the many DX'ers who called in that morning. Best regards in 1971 -
