Gentlemen:

I am pleased to report reception of your station on Sunday, December 29, 1968  
from 4:29 PM to 4:31 1/2 PM Central Standard Time on 1000 kcs.

Items and announcements heard on this broadcast are as follows:

4:29 a Thankyou so much for listening to WVOV, the "TENNESSEE Valley's (this part faded) and your much more music station was announced. Next, an announcement of a religious nature (concerning not going to church) was given.

4:30 "Dixie" was played & then this sign off announcement was given. (I taped it & am reproducing the part 2 could copy below) — "At this time, radio station WVOV concludes another day of broadcasting activities. WVOV is owned & operated by the Tennessee Valley Broadcasting Co. with our ultra-modern studios ... (a brief fade here) & transmitter at 6420 Springfield Rd. in Huntsville, Alabama. WVOV operates with a power of 10000 watts on a frequency of 1000 kilohertz as authorized by the F.C.C. WVOV is a member of the Alabama Broadcasters (over)

Receiver: Hammarlund HQ-180A Signal strength: fair - strongest during the early part of your sign off announcement  
Antenna: 4 1/2 foot loop  
Interference: Heavy from WCFL & KTOK - your signal was not as strong as I'd expect for 10000 watts  
Atmospheric noise: None Fading: As indicated Readability: Are you dir-rectinal?  
Temperature: 40 degrees. Weather: clear
