We are in receipt of your letter dated March 31st, 1953 regarding reception from Radio Station CBY.

Radio Station CBY signs on each week day morning with "God Save the Queen" at twenty-eight minutes and thirty seconds past 7.00 a.m. Newfoundland Standard Time, and was on the air on the morning of March 31, 1953.

From the above in all probability you heard Radio Station CBY, as the time difference between New Jersey and Newfoundland is one and a half hours, making it 6.00 a.m. your time.

As you realize, unless you can give us further details we are unable at this time to confirm your reception.
