It is with pleasure that I inform you that your reception report of August 4th, 1956 has been found correct. We always answer BCL reports, and it is all the more pleasant when they are positive, as yours was.

Radio station CJQC, Quebec City 's only English language station, is on the air from 6.00 AM to 3.00 AM, except Sunday, when sign off takes place at 11.15 PM. As you heard, our power output is 250 watts, our frequency 1340 kcs. Our antenna tower is 186 ft. high.

Incidentally, I notice that you are using the same receiver I used to work with when I was active as VE2MJ, and BCL, SWL as a side line. Although my occupations no longer permit me to devote much time to this side of radio, I still retain my license and interest.
