Dear DX-er:

We at Radio Victoria wish to welcome you to our listening audience. We would like to acknowledge your reception report of March 13, 1963 as being an accurate report of our station at that time and date.

Radio Victoria is one of 27 missionary radio stations proclaiming the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ throughout the world. This station is sponsored by The Evangelical Alliance Mission of Chicago, Ill., U.S.A.. We broadcast from 9:00 A.M. to 11:00 P.M. (local time), in four languages--English, Spanish, Dutch and Papiamento which is the local language. This station went on the air in 1958 with a 5Kw Gates transmitter, 920Kc's; then we have converted our transmitter to 10Kw's and moved to 905Kc's. This shift of frequency was due to local interference. Also it was our desire to find a clearer frequency. We use (2) 3X2500's in parallel driven by (2) push pull 3X2500's. Our line current is 14.1 amps into a 50 ohm coaxial line. We deliver 11.0 amps into a 300X foot marchonie antenna.

DX-ing is a new venture for us here on Aruba. This fall, on the first of each month, at 12 midnight (local time) E.S.T. plus half-hour we will be carrying on a special DXing program. We hope that we might receive a report from your area. In the past six months we have heard from countries such as England, Sweden, Norway, Denmark and the United States. In the States we have been heard in New York, New Jersey, Maryland, Texas, Vermont, Illinois, Connecticut, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania. Since we are starting to DX we hope to hear from many more countries.

Enclosed is some literature about our station and some other literature that might help you in your life. Thank you for your letter and we hope to be hearing from you again.

We at Radio Victoria wish to welcome you to our listening audience. We are glad to acknowledge as accurate your report of the reception of our signal: 7:30 PM EST, 30 March 1964.

Radio Victoria is one of 27 missionary radio stations proclaiming the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ throughout the world. This station is sponsored by The Evangelical Alliance Mission of Chicago Ill., U.S.A. We broadcast from 1000 to 0200 Greenwich Mean Time (0600 to 2200 local time) in four languages-- English, Spanish, Dutch and Papiamento which is the local language. This station went on the air in 1958 with a 5kw Gates transmitter on 920 Kc, since then we have converted our transmitter to 10kw and moved to 900 Kc. Our antenna is a one-quarter wavelength vertical tower located very near sea-level.

Accurate reception reports are a valuable contribution to our work in the engineering department of Radio Victoria. They enable us to more effectively evaluate the technical operation of our equipment and the interference which our signal encounters as it reaches out from the island of Aruba.

Enclosed is some literature about our station. Thank you for your report; we hope to be hearing from you again.
