Dear Sir:

Thank you very much for your letter of November first, informing us of reception in Omaha, Nebraska. I am sorry I haven't replied before now, however, your letter was placed in a wrong file and was "lost" for a while, hence the delay.

This station has been on the air since December 2, 1958...operating at a power output of 1000 watts until last year when we were granted a license to increase our power to 5000 watts on pattern. Our new installation was complete in September 1962...and we officially started to broadcast on 5000 watts on September 20, 1962. We have a four tower array, however, we only operate with three of them at a time, using towers one, two and three on night pattern...and one, two and four on day pattern. In other words we have to use two extra towers in order to facilitate a day-night pattern change.

The sign-off announcement which you submitted for verification is word perfect, indicating that we must have been coming in "very clear". I am enclosing a coverage map and another brochure we use for advertizing purposes...and I hope you can use them in your hobby of DXing. If you wish to have any other information regarding CJDV, I would be pleased to help you in any way. I am very interested in DXing and hope to start this hobby in the near future. Thanks again for your letter, and I'm sorry for the delay in answering.

I hope I can help you in the future...and you're welcome to write for any information you may need or want.
