Dear Mr. Wesolowski:

Thank you very much for your reception report of Radio Station KADL on Wednesday, October 4, 1961 from 1:31am to 1:44am, CST. As you requested, we submit the following information:

KADL is a 5000 watt station, 1270 kcs. operating during the daylight hours. We have studios in the Hotel Pines in downtown Pine Bluff. Our transmitter is located on Highway 15 South, just outside the city limits. (RCA Transmitter). Our tower is 203 Ft. high.

We do not schedule regular frequency checks; however they will nearly always occur between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 5:00am.

Our first day for regularly scheduled broadcasting was August 19, 1960. We are the most powerful Pine Bluff station, covering the entire section of Southeast Arkansas with 5000 powerful watts.
