Dear Sir:

This is in reply to your letter of October 2, reporting reception of our station on that date. Please excuse the delay in replying, but ~~this is~~ a small station and I am the only engineer and I have been in the midst of making some improvements to the station's equipment set-up.

Your description of program content tallies with my log for that period so I am sure that your reception up until about 1:50 A.M. was us as our frequency measurement is conducted from 1:35 to 1:50 a.m. each first Monday morning. We signed off at 1:50, but you definitely had us from 1:45 to 1:50.

Our studios and transmitter are both located in the same building on the Southern boundary of this city of about 6,500, right on the banks of the White River. Our tower, cut $\frac{1}{4}$ wave for this frequency, is 188 feet in overall height. We were using 1000 watts power at the time you received us. Map is enclosed. Thanks.
