Thank you for your letter concerning the reception of our station.

This letter is to verify that Radio Station KDEW AM/FM in DeWitt, Arkansas, signed off the air at 5:00 pm Sunday, December 12, 1976.


KDEW is a daytime AM with an FM simulcast. The AM, as you may know, has to sign off at sunset. During the winter months, and December specifically, our AM sign off is 5:00 pm. Normally our FM continues until 5:30 pm, which is our regular Sunday sign off. You mentioned the other station (KWSL-Sioux City) reducing their power, which is that they have to do instead of signing off completely as we do.

On this particular Sunday we were short-handed, announcer-wise, and a man that fills in for us occasionally took the afternoon programming to 5:00 pm, at which time we told him to just sign both stations off the air together.

Enclosed is a copy of our rate card, a coverage map and a copy of our station profile which tells a little bit about us.
