
I am pleased to confirm your reception of KEOS on March 18, 1973. We do not receive many reception reports because of the interference from XETRA in Mexico which you cited in your report.

KEOS went on the air on 690kHz in September 1969 after receiving the old KVNA channel allocation an many years of design work with the FCC. KVNA went bankrupt in the summer of 1963 just a few months after you received them. They operated with the same night-time directional pattern that we have now. The difference is that we are also directional in the daytime whereas they were not.

KEOS operates 24-hours a day with the exception of Sunday nights when we shut down for maintenance so you might try for us sometime on a weeknight although interference is bound to be greater. We also run frequency checks on the first Sunday night of each month so you might be able to hear that also.

I'm sorry it has taken so long to get this report back to you but it has been a hectic winter. We have had 195 inches of snow this year and that causes problems for radio stations.
