Dear Mr. Wesolowski:

This will confirm your report of reception of KZON, 1190 kc, Tolleson, Arizona, for Wednesday, January 16, 1963. Your report of sign-off and playing of the national anthem on that date at 12-12:02 am MST seems correct.

I regret to say that no KZON letterhead stationary is available since it was allowed to liquidate pending the change of call letters which we received January 23, 1963. This explains this letter coming from KRDS rather than KZON.

Despite the call letter change we are still at 1190 kc, still broadcasting from Tolleson, Arizona, although our business offices are located in Phoenix.

At this time no coverage maps are available. Our antenna array is composed of two towers. The station is equipped with Collins equipment throughout.

I hope this has helped you and my apologies for the month's delay but things have been pretty hectic since we made the change in format from Spanish language to English language in December and we're just beginning to get organized.

Perhaps we can be of more help with a future pick-up you may make. At that time we should be able to send you verification on the station letterhead, which right now is still in the works.
