

The broadcast hours of the station are from 0600  
hours Monday morning to midnight Sunday of each week. This period 0000  
hours to 0600 hours Monday is reserved for general maintenance, and we  
normally transmit our carrier during this period.

A 3-tower directional array is used to project  
our signal across the South-east corner of Vancouver Island and into  
Vancouver. This pattern is also used to protect adjacent frequencies  
in the States.
