This will confirm your reception of KLAC on 570 KHz from
0425 PST to 0444 PST
on 22 NOVEMBER 1972.

The frequency 570 KHz in the United States is classified by the Federal Communications Commission as a Regional Channel and stations operating on this frequency serve a fairly localized region, usually a single metropolitan area. KLAC operates with 5000 Watts of power, 24 hours daily, utilizing a two-tower directional antenna system during hours of darkness. Our radiation pattern at night concentrates the greatest portion of the signal in a generally South-Southwest direction from our transmitter site in Northeast Los Angeles. This enables us to serve, 24 hours a day, nearly all of the densely populated area of Southern California from the San Fernando Valley to San Diego.
