Dear Ernest:

I want to thank you for taking the time to send us a report on receiving our signal in Omaha.

I was running a test broadcast at the time in order for Commercial radio Monitoring Company in Kansas City, Mo to check our frequency.

We do not have extra coverage maps available. Our studios and transmitter are located in the same building, about a mile out from the center of the city at 1612 La Porte Avenue. When the station was built out here in 1948, there were no houses out here, now there are buildings all around us. We are directional at night and we have two towers in our array. Most of our equipment is made by Collins of Cedar Rapids.

We are not a top forty station so we do not have Record Surveys, we do not believe in them.

This is verification that you heard us from 12:06 AM to 12:10 AM October 20, 1962 Mountain Standard Time.
