Dear Mr. Wesolowski,

This will confirm your reception of KFKA on Thursday, December 20, 1973 between the hours of 12:28 AM to 12:34 AM (mountain standard time): during which KFKA was conducting a test for the International Radio Club of America. Your report of reception is completely accurate.

I am very pleased that you were able to pick up the signal. I regret that I was unable to operate at 5kw for a longer period of time, but per the chief engineers instructions I had to change power to 1kw directional.

KFKA, the oldest radio station in Colorado, has been broadcasting since May 21, 1921. Since 1948, we have operated on a frequency of 1310kc's, and since 1963 (when we installed a Gates BC5-P2 transmitter) we have operated with a daytime power of 5000 watts. Our studios are located in downtown Greeley, with our two towers and transmitter west of Evans, Colorado. I have enclosed a copy of our daytime pattern.

I thank you for your report, and hope that you find the information interesting.
