Thank you for your DX report of our frequency check last Monday morning from 12 to 12:15 AM.


We are always pleased to receive DX reports. We normally test on the last Monday morning of the month from 12:00 to 12:15 AM MST.

Our Transmitter and Studios are all located together on the East edge of Alamosa. We have a 150 Tower with a power of 250 Watts. As point of interest the base of the tower is 7535 Feet above sea level, and we are in a large valley completely surrounded by mountains. In the winter the cold air from the snow covered mountains slides down in the valley, and this is the reason we are the coldest spot in the nation excluding of course Alaska.

Under separate cover, I am sending a map of Colorado with the coverage area of K G I W marked on it.
