Good Morning, Mr. Wesolowski:


Thank you very much for your letter of January 26th, regarding your reception of KHOW in Omaha. Your interest and comments are much appreciated.

Inasmuch as the comments you have made on the program material are quite accurate, we are most happy to verify your DX report. I might mention that the name of the announcer on duty at the time you listened in was Ralph Rowland. A further comment would be complete identification of our studio location which is in the Petroleum Club Building in the heart of downtown Denver.

The KHOW transmitting plant is located in Chaffee Park, about 10 miles NW of downtown Denver. The transmitter is a 5,000 watt RCA Model 5E. KHOW operates non-directionally in the daytime and directionally after local sunset. The directional system employs three 320' high self-supporting towers designed by Lehigh Steel. The transmitter site covers approximately 80 acres.

Thanks again for your letter - I hope that I have been able to supply all the information you requested.
