Dear Mr Wesolowski,

Thank you for your letter, reporting reception of 4YA on February 17th. It has been checked against our station log for the day, found correct, so our official Verification Card is enclosed.

We have received many reports on 4YA from various parts of the United States and Canada, and they have proved both interesting and informative.

4YA is a member of our National network, comprising the four YA stations and the YZ transmitters, listed on the back of the card. The programme content is mixed, catering for Rural workers, Women's features, Educational talks, plays, light, middle brow and classical music.

Our studios are situated in Dunedin city, a population of about 105,000, while our transmitter is situated 7 miles out of town and the programmes are fed from studio to transmitter by land line. Our antenna is a 500' vertical mast and is non directional. Our power is 20 kw. Hours of transmission are 1800 - 1120 GMT daily.

There are two other stations in Dunedin.

4YC, on 900 kc with 10 kw power issues an alternative programme to that of 4YA, but caters more fully for classical tastes.

4ZB, on 1040 kc, also with 10 kw, is the Commercial outlet, and programmes are mainly light, with 15 or 30 minute feature plays and serials in the evening.

4YC operates from 0500 - 1100 GMT daily while 4ZB is on from 1800 - 1200 GMT daily. All stations are operated by the New Zealand Broadcasting Corporation.

We thank you for writing and trust that you may be successful in hearing other New Zealand stations, particularly 4YC and 4ZB.
