Thank you for your reception report of "YNOL",  
Waves of light." Enclosed you will find your QSL card  
verifying your report.

YNOL operates on 825 kc. with a power of 15000 watts,  
using three 3x2500P3 tubes in the final. We have the most  
powerful transmitter in all of Central America and it was  
constructed here at YNOL. The antenna is a 305' vertical  
radiator. The transmitter-studio building is located about  
eight miles southwest of Managua, the capital of Nicaragua.  
In addition, we have a downtown studio.

We have been on the air since March, 1959, and are  
broadcasting daily from 6 a.m. - 9:00 p.m. in the Spanish  
language, and from 9:00 - 10:15 p.m. in the English language.  
We trust our programs have been an inspiration to you.
