Dear Mr. Wesolowski;

I am pleased to confirm your reception report of Monday, October 22, 1973 from 1:06AM to 1:15AM on 1450KHz.

We make a special after midnight broadcast once per month so as to overcome QRM for a consultant in Greenville, S.C. to measure our frequency. This is the reason for the tone.

In case you are interested I will list the following parameters: Gates 1-KW/0.25-KW BC-1G Transmitter and acc.,  $\frac{1}{4}$ -wave vertical antenna, Marti Clipper-Limiter. I was operating on 1000-watts with a modulation of about 70% with the 1000-Hertz tone and about 120% modulation during the station IDs.

You will find enclosed, a coverage mape for both our AM and FM systems. By the way, I also broadcast an FM test at the same time, but without the tone.
