I am pleased to report reception of your station on Friday, December 14, 1973
from 7:29 AM to 7:32 AM Eastern Standard Time on 1010 KHz.

Items and announcements heard on this broadcast are as follows:

- 7:29 EST OPEN CARRIER with no modulation.
7:30 SIGN-ON ANNOUNCEMENT: "This is Radio Station W G U N in Atlanta, Georgia, beginning broadcast operations for today. W G U N operating at 10-10 Khz., with 50,000 watts. Stay tuned for the very best in (Country-Western music ?). Now ladies and gentlemen, our National Anthem."
7:30:30 NATIONAL ANTHEM
7:31:45 (complete Loss-of-Signal to CBR in Calgary, Alberta.)

About two or three mornings ago I heard your station sign on at this same time but you were much weaker than today and I could not copy as much as this! Station CBR in Calgary also signs on at 7:30am your time, making it hard to copy you as they are nearly 180° in the opposite direction from Omaha. One other item. Where the announcer gave the frequency of 10-10 Khz, he may have said "WGUN operating with 500, 10,000 and 50,000 watts. That part was covered by CBR and was hard to copy.

May I please have a verification of reception, typed on your WGUN stationery stating the date & time of this report? Do you also have a COVERAGE MAP available? Thank you so very much for your time & interest in our hobby of DXing. I believe you were operating with 10kws at this time!
