Thank you very much for your Report of Reception of our test broadcasts on *March 2, 1962*. Your report has been verified and logged in the station files. Reports have been received from as far as California, Canada, and New Zealand, and all reports are sincerely appreciated.

WSMA uses a 10,000 watt Gates Transmitter, type EG-10P, with Gates and Ampex audio equipment. Our 196 foot tower is located just east of US Highway 41, some ten miles north of the city of Atlanta. The tower is within sight of Dobbins Air Force Base and the Lockheed Aircraft Plant. The studios are in the Belmont Hills section of Smyrna, Georgia.

WSMA will operate normally during the daylight hours, with test broadcasts between 12:01 AM and 6:00 AM EST at irregular intervals. It is hoped that WSMA-FM will be on the air in the near future.

Reception reports, such as the one received from you, enable us to establish our radiation pattern and to verify our engineering specifications. Again, may we thank you, and invite you to visit the WSMA facilities if you are ever in the Atlanta-Smyrna area.
