
Thank you very much for your reception report. I have checked our logs and found your information to be correct. Therefore, I can verify your reception of WWNS on December 15, 1975 from 0221 to 0230 EST. Actually, the test ran from 0115 to 0530 EST--we decided to stay on a bit later than originally scheduled. Between the ID's at the time you were listening, we were running march music. After about 0300 EST we started running classical music. Although this was quite a bit different than the usual fare on 1240, it probably made it a bit hard to copy.

I noted with interest the weather at the time of reception. It reminds me of the weather I became familiar with when I lived just south of Omaha, in Bellevue--just a few miles from the KFAB transmitter site. At the time (1963-67) my father was stationed at Offutt AFB. It was in high school in Bellevue that I became really interested in amateur and commercial radio and in DX'ing and SWL'ing.

Thanks for the KOIL survey (I was an avid listener). I'm afraid we don't have a survey, but I will enclose some info about Statesboro, a copy of a contour map, a sketch of our antenna system, and rate cards for WWNS and our sister station, WMCD-FM.
