Sorry we didn't get a letter back to you sooner. I hope that this one will help to clear up some of the mystery.

We do confirm that on both dates mentioned by you in your letter, we were on the air for the purpose of conducting a frequency check.


As to your questions. I hope that this will answer some of your questions. We have only one tower with OVERALL height of 161 feet 5 inches, ~~SERTAS~~-excited, top loaded and vertical, with a ground system consisting of 240 equally spaced radials, 120 to 150 feet and 120-50 feet long. We operated with 500 watts, using an antenna current of 3.57 and on a non-directional basis.

We operate by remote control from a downtown studio location, to our transmitter, which is located about .1 miles from the West edge of Washington, or about a mile from the studio.

We sincerely hope that this will answer your question, if not, feel free to write, as we will be more than glad to answer anymore questions you may have.

Thanks for the dime for coffee...we'll try to return the favor sometime.
