Dear Mr. Wesolewski,

I am very glad to confirm your reception report of Thursday, 1-3-63. Your report of reception between 1:13 and 1:32 A.M. correspond with our log.

We are out of coverage maps at the moment, but I'll try to remember to send you one when we get more.

Our equipment is almost entirely Collins, as you thought it might be. We operate at 1000 watts, DA-D, with a four tower antenna system, and our main lobe 330° True. The four towers are 180 feet tall and are top loaded by the top 41.5 feet of guy cables.

The studio is located at 202 S.G.A. Building in downtown Cedar Rapids. The transmitters are located about a mile and a half east of Cedar Rapids and about half a mile north of US highway 30.

We also have a stereo FM station operating on 98.1 Mc. with 4200 watts ERP and a six element Collins ring antenna system atop tower 1 of the AM array.

I don't know Mr. Gersuch, but I have exchanged a few letters with Mr. Bernard Duffy of Staten Island, New York. I plan to join the NRC as soon as possible.

I certainly appreciate your very neat, accurate, and complete report. I always find it a real pleasure to receive DX reports. My interest in radio is indeed intense. I have amateur license KØHTF as well as CB.
