This is the first time that I have heard KILR Radio from Omaha. Last weekend our family visited the Dutch Program in Orange City. I tuned in your station and heard it till just South of Sioux City on the car radio. I have tried around your local Sunset time many times but failed to hear you until this morning. Interference was bad from Wichita, Kansas, but at times, you were over them. At 6am, there was no sign of you. Wichita is heard hear all day long with their 10kws.
