Sorry this reply is reaching you so late, but like they say, better late than never. Probably the main reason you never received a reply was due to the fact that at that time KMCD did not have a full time engineer, and the manager was probably too busy to reply. I am, however, now the full time engineer, and as a ham, can more easily understand your situation. In the future, it will be quite easy to get a confirmation from KMCD.

Checking back in the old transmitter and program logs, I find your reception accurate. Therefore, this is to confirm your reception of KMCD, Fairfield, Iowa, the morning of August 25, 1963, at 5:30 am. to 5:34 am.

The studios of KMCD are located in downtown Fairfield, on the east side of the square. In fact we moved into town from the transmitter last November. The transmitting site is located 2 miles west of Fairfield on the south side of highway 34.

Transmitter: Collins 300-J 250 watts


Tower: 185' uniform cross section guyed steel grounded at the base and shunt fed.

Ground system: 120 underground radials 200' long
100 underground radials 50' long.

Transmitter on remote control using Rust 108-R1 equipment.

Please find enclosed a coverage map. Again very sorry that we're just now getting around to this confirmation.
