Dear Ernest,

Thank you for your reception report on KOUR Radio's frequency check on September 15. It is correct and I am happy to send you this official verification.

KOUR first went on the air at 8:38am CST, December 10, 1959, so we are not quite a year old. The transmitter is located on the northeast edge of town with studios located downtown. The transmitter is controlled by remote equipment from our downtown studios. We also have remote studios in Manchester, Iowa, about 23 miles east of Independence.

The tower is a $\frac{1}{4}$ wave length, 202 ft. high, guyed. The ground system consists of radials, each 202 ft. long spaced 3 degrees apart and spreading out in a full circle.

Most of our reports are from NRC members, though since we went on the air, we don't get too many. Our chief engineer has most of the early ones and I have not seen them, so I don't know how many we've issued or to whom.
