This is to verify the reception of Radio Station K Q X V,
1560 kHz, located in Council Bluffs, Iowa on Monday March 12,
1979.

The station is equipped with a new McMartin BA-1K transmitter
operating at 1000 watts to the antenna. The audio is processed
with a 'Dorough' AGC peak limiter. The antenna is a 330 foot
'Stainless' model 25 tower.

K Q X V plans a format change around the 15th of April to News
Talk. The station will use Commodity News Network, ABC and AP
Radio Networks plus a highly talented local force for news
gathering and reporting.

K Q X V Radio plans a call letter change and is currently
requesting the assignment of call letters K L N G from the
Federal Communications Commission.
