Dear Mr. Wesolowski:

I am pleased to acknowledge your reception report of Monday, December 25, 1967. Your report of reception of station KWBG, Boone, Iowa, on a frequency of 1590 KHz at 12:09 to 12:10 AM is accurate, as it checks with our log.

Our station operates 1000 watts daytime, and 500 watts directional at night. Our two tower directional array is oriented on a bearing of 336° true, with the major lobe to the NW. Our field strength at one mile in your approximate direction is about 90 mv/m. It is very unusual that you would be able to receive our signal in Omaha.

I have enclosed a daytime coverage map. I am sorry that we don't have a copy of our night time map to send you.
