Please accept our apology for the failure to reply to your 1963 reception report. Since that time the station has undergone an almost complete turn-over in personnel.


Thank you for your excellent reception report. We are always pleased to hear from DXers.

WSUI is a non-commercial public radio station owned and operated by The University of Iowa. The station broadcasts with a power of 5Kw. Our antenna system is a three-tower directional array with the main beam going ten degrees west of due North. The towers and transmitter are located on the western edge of Iowa City. A coverage map is enclosed.
