Dear Mr. Wesolowski:

This letter will tend to verify our telephone conversation of Monday morning, July 28, 1975, at which time I strongly protested your letter dated July 25, accusing radio station WFRL of an early sign-on.

Please find enclosed a copy of our current broadcast license to operate on a frequency of 1570 kHz. You will see that it very clearly states that we may operate this radio station with a sign-on of 5:15 a.m.

I also question the authenticity of the 5:13 CDT sign-on. Perhaps, your clock can be as much as two minutes off.

Before making accusing remarks and such "hush-hush" statements as your postscript, it might be well to check with the radio station in question.

We do acknowledge receipt of your letter and verification of receipt of signal.
