I wish to thank you for the nice letter you wrote in regards to reception of WJJD. We have not received a large number of verifications from Omaha because of the interference from KSL which is on 1160 also.

I have been on vacation for about a month and am sorry for the delay in verification of your report.

The studios of WJJD are located at 230 North Michigan Ave. in the Carbon and Carbide building. The transmitter is near DesPlaines, Illinois which is about 23 miles northwest of the studios. The power we use at all times is 50,000 watts and a two tower directional antenna with towers of 225 feet and 300 feet in height.

I know Romy very well and hope to visit with him when we are in Omaha in the near future. The days that were spent working in radio from 1925 to 1939 in Omaha are very vivid in my memory because of the many changes that took place during those years.

The study of Electrical Engineering should be very helpful in fitting you for a position in radio or electronics and to a rich future.
