We are indeed pleased to verify your reception of W-NUS, first all-news radio station in the United States, as follows:

Received W-NUS on 1390 kilocycles from 1:07 to 1:25 AM C.S.T. on Wednesday, January 13, 1965. Receiver was National NC-183D with 17 tubes; heard newscast which included sports, weather and station identification.

Since we have no QSL cards, we hope the above will be satisfactory for your files.

We are attaching an old WYNR letterhead and a coverage map as you requested, as well as a letter by Gordon McLendon, President of the McLendon Stations, explaining the change from WYNR to W-NUS. Our transmitter is located at 8601 South Kedzie, on the southwest side of Chicago. We have 4 towers there.
