
Dear Ernest:

Congradulations! You now hold the distance record for WGOM. Prior to your report, we reached Lincoln, Neb., last winter, but never such luck during the summer months. Thanks for your report. I am in contact with one of your club members in Lincoln who has promised to arrange a DX test for us this coming winter.

We're a 250 watt daytimer here, 2 tower directional. Parts of Indiana are known for super ground conductivity, and our area is no exception. Our signal is comparable to many of the country's 5KW stations. If you'll look at the enclosed coverage map, the south .5 mv/m contour is almost linear, and that line is 65 miles out.

Please accept this letter as verification of your reception on Friday, June 29th, from 1:35 - 2:14AM EDT, as we were testing at that time, and your report follows what was aired to the letter.
