Dear DXer:

Please excuse the form type letter, but we have received so many reports that it impossible to answer each one personally. I tried with about fifteen or so reports, but then realized that I would still be doing it about December 25th. By this preceeding statement, you can realize that we had very good results from the broadcast. All reports either had correct times of tones, or word-for-word loggings of my IDs.

This letter is given to you as official verification of reception of radio station WNWI on November 6, 1966.

We received 46 reports from 20 states and also including 3 from Ontario and one from Quebec. The farthest report came from a listener in a car in Tampa, Florida. Also we received good reports from Houston, Texas, Boston, Mass., and also one from a listener only 45 miles from WTIC.

The equipment here is mostly RCA in the studio and transmitter. We also have various makes of tape recorders and modulation limiters. The tower is a 310 foot vertical, guyed, non-directional antenna with approximately 33,000 feet of buried #10 copper wire for a ground system.

Again, thank you very much for the overwhelming success of the broadcast, and perhaps we might be on the air again, if conditions ever improve on 1080 at all.
