Our Chief Engineer has evidently misplaced your other letter, without answering it.



We appreciate your confirmation of our signal report on June 30, 1963.

We operate on an assigned frequency of 1560 kc and a power of 250w.



We are extremely fortunate to have a ground conductivity of 30% at our transmitter site, which should allow us ordinary primary coverage of six counties in this area.

Of course, the heaviside layer and the time of the morning has given us skips into your area as well as others: eg Connecticut, Canada, Colorado, Oklahoma etc.

Our equipment is 100% Collins. The studios proper are located in the Sunflower Building in downtown Abilene, with transmitter site approximately two miles away, and control is maintained through the use of a Sheaffer remote. Collins cartridge units and Ampex tape recorders are used. Microphones are Collins and RCA Victor 77.
