
The rig here at KGNO is a Gates 5B that uses a Pair of 3X2500F3's to modulate a single 3X2500F3. The rig runs 5KW non-directional daytime and 1KW directional nighttime. Your logging is at the 5KW non-directional level.

Sure wish I had the room for a rhombic. I am very sure that you would enjoy hamming much more; the KNØSEG can still be worked out you know.
