Dear Mr. Wesolowski:

This is to confirm your reception of KIUL on the morning of Saturday, April 7, 1962. We were on the air from 12:05 to 12:20 with our monthly frequency check. The items that you heard were correct according to our operating log.

In answer to your questions, we are at the present time 1000 watts daytime, but still 250 watts at night. We use an RCA BTA-1R transmitter and a series-fed 210 foot ^{guide} antenna. Our studios are located in downtown Garden City, and our transmitter is located on the northwest edge of the city. I am enclosing a coverage map which shows our primary interference-free daytime signal and our secondary daytime signal.
