Dear Sir:

It was a pleasure to receive your letter advising us that you were able to pick up our signal from 11:58 p.m. to 1:11 a.m. C.S.T. on Saturday, January 12th.

We've checked your record on what you heard and find it coincides exactly with the times we have logged for the last portion of our broadcast day. The 1:10:30 a.m. meditation to which you refer is part of our closing format, and "The Queen" is the only other bit of music to follow this meditation.

It may be of interest to you to know that CFAR recently celebrated its twenty-fifth anniversary, having commenced broadcasting in the north on November 14th, 1937. Our transmitter is located at Cliff Lake, about three miles north of Flin Flon, at Lat: 54 - 48 - 06 Long: 101 - 51 - 04; Twp. 67, Range 29, West of the Principal Meridian. Studios, of course, are in Flin Flon. We broadcast on a non-directional pattern.

I regret that we do not have an engineered coverage map available to forward, but I am enclosing other information which may be of interest to you.
