

WPGC AM operates with 10,000 watts of power from sunrise to
sunset local (Washington, D. C.) time. The station employs a
two tower directional antenna to offer protection to stations
to the northeast of our transmitter location.

WPGC-FM operates with 50,000 watts of power (circularly polarized)
24 hours a day 7 days a week. Antenna height is 500 feet above
average terrain. Coverage maps of both the stations are enclosed.

Dear Mr. Wesolowski:

We wish to thank you for your recent reception report of WPGC AM. We receive many reports of this kind each week and welcome them.

For the past year we have been ever so surprised to receive reports of our signal being received in several locations which we normally have thought to be a null. Our directional antenna pattern has been designed to heavily protect stations close to and operating on our channel, 1580 Khz. Because this frequency is, by international treaty, a Canadian Clear Channel with the primary use of the frequency by CBJ Chicoutimi, Quebec. Thus limiting our operation to daytime with little hope for presunrise transmission provisions.

In answer to your question concerning WPGC sign-on policy. We have not for many years given sign-on or sign-off information about our stations. We have and still feel that we are in no position to repeat vital information which is included, by FEC Law, in our station's public file located at both the FCC Washington, D.C. and at our offices. WPGC has been one of the most listener accepted radio stations in the country. Recently, we felt that we caused confusion with the listeners in sign-off of the AM. So, we started giving a simple sign-off announcement informing the public that we are required by FCC and international laws to leave the air till the next day at sunrise, and that we continue to serve the community 24 hours a day with our FM. We offer total community involvement, musical entertainment, programming, contests and promotions 24 hours each day with our full quality FM Stereo station. WPGC simulcasts 100%.

Enclosed please find our most recent coverage maps for both stations. Please bear in mind that we are constantly changing and trying to upgrade the signals of the stations, so these maps are not completely accurate. Once again, thank you for your interest in WPGC.
