KOLM Radio is pleased to receive your reception report verifying that our signal reached Omaha.

KOLM Radio operates on an assigned frequency of 1520 Kz. and a power of 10,000 watts during the day. During critical hours we broadcast with 1,000 watts. We are authorized by the FCC to sign on with the PSA (Pre-sunrise authorization) power of 50 watts. We were granted this only in January of this year. Prior to January we were only authorized to sign on with 1.15 watts of power.

KOLM Radio and FM-Station KWWK are both owned and operated by the Olmsted County Broadcasting Company Incorporated. We began broadcasting on October 10, 1963. Our format at that time was easy-listening and in 1968 switched to the Country Western format.

I am enclosing a coverage map which you requested. Thank you for your reception report and interest in our station.
